

Inland Trader Darts League Rule notes

All matches will be scheduled for Tuesday night 8.30pm
Subs for summer season 5€ per player. To be collected by each team captain and to be left at Bar for collection along with team players sheet. All subs and sheets are required by June 15th.

MATCH STRUCTURE

Each match consists of nine games (5 singles, 3 doubles & 1 team game).

Player order to be determined by a blind draw

Possible points to be won 9.

- a.. 5 Matches of 301, best of 3, single player, straight start, double finish.
Match = 1 point.
- b. 3 Matches . Doubles best of three, 501, straight start, double out.
Match =1 point.
- c. 1 Team Match 701 best of three. Match 1 point

The Match Points are the total of the game points, therefore a match score can result in 9-0, 8-1, 7-2, 6-3 or 5-4 to either team.

Points will be awarded to each team as per the match score above and totalled throughout the season.

PLAYERS

Teams consist of a minimum of 5 players.

Subs for summer season 5€ per player. To be collected by each team captain and to be left at Bar for collection along with team players sheet. All subs and sheets are required by June 15th

No individual player may play on more than one team during the season.

If a team has the minimum five players the 3rd doubles match will be made up of the player who has not already participated in a doubles match and one of the other team members who must be selected blind.

SHORTAGE OF PLAYERS ON THE NIGHT.

It is possible to play with only 4 players and still win.

If a team only has four players present, they forfeit 1 singles and 1 doubles game.

The Team game is played as normal. i.e. they do not “miss” a throw during the team game in the absence of their 5th player.

MATCH PLAY RULES

On the start of each game, both players throw for bull and the player nearest the bull starts the 1st leg.

The 2nd leg is started by the player who threw second in the 1st leg.

If it goes to the third leg then both players throw for bull again to decide who starts the third leg.

Players may not remove their darts from the board until their score is recorded and acknowledged by the opponent.

FAILURE TO TURN UP OR NOTIFY YOUR OPPONENTS IN GOOD TIME.

If your team are unable to make the match the opposing team must be contacted and informed by no later **12PM ON THE DAY OF PLAY TUESDAY.**

If they are not notified before this time then **THEY ARE NOT OBLIGED TO RESCHEDULE** the match and the match points will be awarded to your opponents. (see below Match points awarded.)

If a team fails to turn up, and have not contacted the opposing team they forfeit the match and the opponents will be awarded the points.

MATCH POINTS AWARDED.

The opponents will be awarded a minimum of 5 points

At the end of the season the team's average will be calculated and if their average is more than 5 points the score will be adjusted accordingly. If the team average is less than 5, the points awarded will remain the same.

RESCHEDULED MATCHES

Rescheduled matches must be organised and played with in two weeks of the original match date. If this does not take place then the team who originally failed to make the original match date will forfeit the game and the match will be awarded to their opponents as per above

CAPTAINS

Home team CAPTAINS are responsible for providing the evening scores

All captains are required to keep a record of the scores and it is advisable to confirm that you both have the same results at the end of the evening to avoid disputes later.

All scores will be updated each week and published at www.inlandtraderonline.com (See Darts) and fortnightly in the newspaper.

The captains of each team are responsible for the smooth running of the match. Any dispute that arises during the course of play must be settled in private conference by the team captains. If need be you can call Lou at Inland trader office or Steve at the Plough .

FAIR PLAY

Inland Trader Darts League Rule notes

Heckling or other harassment is UNACCEPTABLE. Overly loud and constant cheering or yelling is also UNACCEPTABLE. It is BOTH teams' responsibility to maintain the best of order during play.

The repeated use of foul and/or insulting language and/or resorting to physical violence shall be considered just cause for the penalizing of the offender and/or the team. The penalty imposed will depend on the seriousness of the offense.

NOISE. A visiting team has the prerogative of requesting that noise is kept to a tolerable level whilst throwing.
